Stephen Ministers will meet once a week with a care receiver for about an hour to listen, care, encourage, and pray for the care receiver. The Stephen Minister brings Christ's presence into the person's life; Stephen Ministry is God's Love in Action. A Stephen Minister receives 50 hours of initial training to **provide one-to-one care to their care receivers**; they will meet twice a month with Stephen Leaders for supervision, support and continuing education.
